

Keighley Albion Code of Conduct for Junior Players

As a player of Keighley Albion, we understand you have the right to:

- Enjoy the time you spend with us and know that you are safe
- Be told who you can talk to if something is not right and be listened to
- Be respected by other players and be treated fairly
- Feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality, faith or ability
- Be encouraged to develop your Rugby League skills with our help and support
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury and have your parents/quardians informed, where appropriate

As a junior player of Keighley Albion we expect you to:

- Keep yourself safe by listening to your coach, team and club volunteers, behave responsibly and speak out when something isn't right
- Take care of our equipment and facilities as if they were your own
- Not wander off or leave training or a match without telling your coach
- Always give 100% effort
- Encourage teammates who make mistakes
- Not argue with the match officials
- Play as a team
- Welcome all new players, from all backgrounds, whether or not they have played before
- Treat all players, volunteers and match officials with RESPECT
- Attend all training sessions when possible

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action being taken against you by the Disciplinary Committee of Keighley Albion. Continued issues and repeated breaches may result in exclusion from Keighley Albion.
