



Keighley Albion Code of Conduct for Open Age Players

As an Open Age player of Keighley Albion, we understand you have the right to:

- Be respected by other players and be treated fairly
- Feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality, faith or ability
- Be encouraged to develop your Rugby League skills with our help and support
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury
- Make a complaint to the committee

As an Open Age player of Keighley Albion, we expect you to:

- Attend all training sessions where possible and inform coaches if unable to attend a session
- Make sure that you have the appropriate kit for training and games
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit. Make every effort to develop your own abilities
- Tell us if you wish to talk to us about any concerns you have regarding any aspect of Keighley Albion
- Care for and respect the facilities and equipment made available to you by and at Keighley Albion
- Be a role model for open age and junior players of Keighley Albion
- Be a good sport, respect all good play whether from your team or the opposition
- Safeguard your health; don't use any illegal or unhealthy substances
- Any player found in possession of illegal substances whilst on club grounds will be removed from the club grounds with immediate effect and must appear before the disciplinary committee
- Never engage in discriminatory or unacceptable conduct of any sort including swearing, obscene gestures, offensive remarks, taunting or other actions that are demeaning or disrespectful to other players, officials or supporters.
- Respect the match officials' decisions - don't complain or argue about decisions during or after the game
- At all times follow the directions of the match day or club volunteers
- Behave! Unsporting or discriminatory language, harassment or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action being taken against you by the Disciplinary Committee of Keighley Albion. Continued issues and repeated breaches may result in exclusion from Keighley Albion.
