## As a parent / guardian of a player we understand you have the right to:

- Be assured that your child is safeguarded during their time with us
- Know who to contact with any concerns about training and how to contact them
- Know that any concerns about your child's welfare will be listened to and responded to
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your child, where appropriate
- Know the procedure should you child be involved in an accident or become injured
- Make a complaint to the committee

## As a parent / guardian of a player we expect you to:

- Make sure that your child has appropriate kit for training / games and a drink
- Ensure that your child arrives to sessions on time and is picked up promptly
- Inform us if you are running late to collect your child or if your child is going home with someone else
- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in sport
- Remember that children participate in Rugby League for their own enjoyment not yours
- Understand that rugby league is part of a total life experience, and the benefits of involvement go far beyond the final score of a game
- Encourage players to play by the rules and to respect opposition players and officials
- Participate in positive cheering that encourages all the players in a team; do not engage in any jeering that taunts or intimidates opponents, their fans or officials
- Respect the match officials' decisions don't complain or argue about decisions during or after a game
- Complete all consent, contact and medical forms and update us straight away if anything changes
- Maintain a good relationship with your child's coach and team volunteers i.e. team manager
- Tell us if you wish to talk to us about any concerns regarding your child. We will arrange a mutually convenient time so you can talk to us
- Not enter the pitch or interrupt training or matches unless in an emergency situation
- At all times, follow the directions of the match day or club volunteers
- Behave! Unsporting or discriminatory language, harassment or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated
